






# CARIBBEAN CORAL REEF WATCH



## Notable Observations


- Increasing SSTs in the Caribbean sea. Severe bleaching reported in Sapodilla Cays Marine Reserve, Belize, with that region under Alert Level 2.
- Bleaching warnings issued for NE Cuba and Cayman. Alert Level 1 and 2 issued for entire Central America, Mexico (Quintana Roo), ABC islands, Colombia, Venezuela, Jamaica, and Southern Hispaniola.
- Most of Caribbean under watch. Some cooling observed in the N. Caribbean and north-western Atlantic as a result of hurricane activity in those areas.

## Current Global Conditions

- Majority of East Asia under Alert Level 1 and 2 except Parcel Is., N. Taiwan, S. Vietnam and N. Ryukyu Is.
- Large percentage of Micronesian islands under Alert Level 2 and expected to remain so into November.
- Northern Philippines, Northern Hawaiian Islands, and Cape Verde Islands all under Alert Level 1..




## Alert Level Guide


Alert Level	Interpretation
No Stress	No Thermal Stress
Watch	Low-level thermal stress
Warning	Thermal stress is accumulating
Alert level 1	Bleaching expected
Alert level 2	Widespread bleaching and some mortality expected

## Current Outlook (Oct 2017-Jan 2018)

- 4-Month Outlook indicates that Bleaching Thermal Stress will be at Alert Level 2 in 1-4 weeks (Oct).




## Caribbean Bleaching Outlook
