## wet days and wet spells outlooks June to August 2016

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
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








### Wet day frequency shifts Forecast for: June to August 2016




USUALLY: Across the region during June-July-August, about 35 to 70 days are wet days.

FORECAST: JJA rainfall is likely to be above- to normal in many parts of the Antilles, as well as the western half of the Guianas, but below- to normal in Belize. Fewer wet days than normal (low to medium confidence) are forecast across the region.


#### **IMPLICATION:**

- Increasing surface wetness;
- Increasing disruption of outdoor activities (however perhaps less often than usual).




### Wet spells frequency shifts Forecast for: June to August 2016

JJA 2016 frequency of 7-day very wet spells




USUALLY: Roughly 3 to 6 wet spells occur between June & August, of which 1 to 3 are very wet.


FORECAST: JJA rainfall is likely to be above- to normal in many parts of the Antilles, as well as the western half of the Guianas, but below- to normal in Belize. Fewer wet days and wet spells than normal are forecast, except for the Guianas where more wet spells are forecast (low to medium confidence).

#### **IMPLICATION:**


**Recharging of large water reservoirs** after a prolonged drought.

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






#### **Extreme wet spells frequency shifts** Forecast for: June to August 2016

JJA 2016 frequency of *extreme* (top 1%) 3-day wet spells



# USUALLY: Up to 1 extreme wet spell occurs between June & August.

**FORECAST: JJA rainfall is likely to be** above- to normal in many parts of the Antilles, as well as the western half of the Guianas, but below- to normal in Belize. Fewer wet days and wet spells than normal are forecast, except for the Guianas where more wet spells are forecast (low to medium confidence). There is an increased chance of extreme wet spells in the **Lesser Antilles (***medium to high* confidence), whereas no frequency shifts are forecast elsewhere.

## IMPLICATION: Flash flood potential developing.
