### Notable Observations


- Previous 4-month Coral Bleaching Outlook for the Caribbean realised with heat stress worsening. Alert level
  1 issued for the Eastern Leeward islands and Eastern Jamaica. Belize experiencing Alert level 2 conditions.
- As of the end of August, Sea Surface Temps. were slightly above average in most other areas and the unusual warmth around the Windwards decreased. <u>Read more...</u>

- Bleaching watch and warning alerts issued in Cape Verde Is, and throughout the Pacific (especially Micronesia), Southeast Asia, and the Indian Ocean.
- Johnston Atoll (Pacific remote Is), Ogasawara Is., and Marshall Is. under Alert Level 1. Veracruz (Mexico), Yucatan Peninsula, NW and main Hawaiian Is., Kiribati, Nauru, and Hong Kong under Alert Level 2 conditions.




#### **Alert Level Guide**

Alert Level	Interpretation
No Stress	No Thermal Stress
Watch	Low-level thermal stress
Warning	Thermal stress is accumulating
Alert level 1	Bleaching expected
Alert level 2	Widespread bleaching and some mortality expected

+ 4-Month Outlook indicates that Coral Bleaching Heat Stress will be at Alert Level 2 during Oct and Nov.





Caribbean Satellite Bleaching Alert Area and Outlook 2019-09-30




Current Coral Bleaching Alert Level










Bleaching Outlook Weeks 13-16 (Jan)

Alert Level 1 and/or 2 conditions currently exist around Cuba, S. Hispaniola, Puerto Rico, **Belize, Lesser Antilles,** and Leeward Antilles. Alert level 2 forecasted for the Leeward Islands, with the exception of Dominica, in November.
