Weather Assessment for the period (11th – 19th) of April 2020.

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


Figure 1. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during period 11th to 19th of April 2020.

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


Figure 2. Rainfall map of Tobago showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during period 11th to 19th of April 2020.

During the second dekad of April, mostly relatively dry days occurred in both Trinidad and Tobago except in little pockets in northwest, eastern and southern Trinidad, where few relative wet days occurred. Rainfall total maps for the period 11th to 19th of April are located below as figure 1 and figure 2.

Trinidad's Mean Daily Rainfall Forecast for the Third Dekad of April (21st-30th) 2020.

Northern & Northwestern areas:

Moderate chance (60%) of mean daily rainfall up to 2.3 mm.

North-Eastern and Eastern areas:

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 3.7 mm.

Central, West-Central and inland areas:

Moderate chance (60%) of mean daily rainfall up to 1.5 mm.

South-Eastern areas:

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Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 4.0 mm.

Southern areas:

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 3.6 mm.

South-Western areas:

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 3.4 mm.




Figure 3. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing possible rainfall totals for varying districts during third dekad of April 2020 and percentage probability of occurrence.

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Tobago's Mean Daily Rainfall Forecast for the Third Dekad of April (21st -30th) 2020.

Northeastern areas:

Moderate chance (60%) of mean daily rainfall up to 2.3 mm.

South-Western areas:

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 2.9 mm.




Figure 4. Rainfall map of Tobago showing possible rainfall totals for varying districts during third dekad of April 2020 and percentage probability of occurrence.

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Impacts on Agriculture:

During the third dekad of April 2020, equal amounts are likely of relatively dry and relatively wet days. Expect relatively dry days on the 21st, 25th, 26th, 27th, 28th, and relatively wet days on the 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 29th and 30th. There is a moderate (30%) probability that the rainfall anticipated, might return small amounts of soil moisture across Trinidad and Tobago. Rivers will continue to be very low, shrubs and grass growth will continue at a very slow pace. Additionally, the heat season is upon us, with rising mean temperatures, there is a high (72%) probability of insects, pests and warm weather diseases may possibly develop.

Sun and Moon positions in the sky:

The sun is presently at latitude of approximately 11.5 degrees north latitude, and with this position, the day length for this dekad will be 12.4 hours. A high probability (80%) of intense solar radiation occurring during the third dekad of April 2020, when the sky is generally cloud free. There is high probability (80%) of heat stress on variety of plant seedlings and young/sick/elderly animals from direct exposure to solar radiation and high temperatures. Additionally, the moon's new moon phase will be on the 22nd of April 2020 and first quarter phase will be on the 30th April 2020. As a result, there will be medium to low moon illumination over crop fields and livestock at night during the dekad.

Summary:

During the third dekad of April 2020, equal amounts are likely of relatively dry and relatively wet days. Expect relatively dry days on the 21st, 25th, 26th, 27th, 28th, and relatively wet days on the 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 29th and 30th. On relatively dry days expect few cloudy patches with a low probability (20%) of a brief shower; while on relatively wet days expect intermittent cloudy patches with a moderate probability (45%) of brief showers.
