Frequent excessive heat from August to October


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How hot will the next three to six months be?



- Overall, at least as warm as usual in most areas between July and September 2021.
- At least as warm as usual daytime 2. conditions expected from Oct. to Dec. in Barbados, the Guianas, Trinidad and Tobago, and the Windward Is.


IMPLICATIONS:


- Heat stress in the vulnerable population & small livestock through September (Bahamas and **Greater Antilles), October (ABC** Is., Guianas, and Lesser Antilles).
- **Higher than usual temperatures** combined with high humidity means higher cooling need until **October, particularly at night, but** also during the day in most places.


The Caribbean Heat Season: April/May to October




How many heatwave days on average per month?











How many heatwave days to expect in **July 2021**?




USUALLY: 6-12 heatwave days in the islands north of Martinique. FORECAST: Except in the Bahamas, Barbados, Dominica, Cayman Is., parts of Cuba, Jamaica and Sint Maarten, where up to 15 heatwave days are possible, no more than 5 heatwave days are

What do we expect for July to September 2021, i.e. the **peak of the heat season** in **The Bahamas** and the **Greater Antilles**?





Prob. at least 15 heatwave days between Jul & Sep 2021




Prob. at least 30 heatwave days between Jul & Sep 2021



USUALLY: around 15-25 heatwave days over 3 months.

FORECAST: Over 50% chance for at least 15 heatwave days, except in Belize and the Guianas. 30 heatwave days or more are likely in the Bahamas and Barbados.



How many heatwave days from July till September 2021?

USUALLY:

- 1) In most years, 15-25 heatwave days occur from July to September across the Caribbean islands, but fewer than 15 occur in Belize and the Guianas.
- 2) There are between 6 and 12 heatwave days on average in July in the islands north and west of Martinique, but fewer than 6 in most other locations.

FORECAST:

- The number of heatwave days during the peak of the 2021 heat season in the Bahamas and the Lesser Antilles (July to September) is expected to be close to the usual.
- Note that areas with more abundant rainfall than usual will see daytime temperatures and the frequency of heatwaves tempered.

IMPLICATIONS:

- In the event of heatwaves, of which more than 5 can occur (especially during dry spells), heat stress in human populations or livestock will sharply increase.
- While episodes of heat stress are expected in the Caribbean Islands, particularly in August and September, it should be less severe than during the hottest years (e.g. 2020).





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
