Frequent excessive heat in October in the Guianas and the southeastern Caribbean Islands





- Temperatures are expected to hover around the usual as the region transitions out of the 2021 Heat Season (April/May to October) and into to the cool season (December to March).
- Cold nights may be more frequent than usual from January, with the likely exception of islands south of Guadeloupe.


IMPLICATIONS:


- Recurrent heat stress in the vulnerable population & small livestock through October in the ABC Is. and the Lesser Antilles and from mid-November in the Guianas.
- High temperatures and humidity increase cooling need until October.


The Caribbean Heat Season: April/May to October




How many heatwave days on average per month?











How many heatwave days to expect in **October 2021**?

Heatwaves in October (1991-2020 avg.)



USUALLY: 3-7 heatwave days in October in the islands east- and southwards of Puerto Rico, 9-15 heatwave days in the Guianas, but fewer than 3 elsewhere. FORECAST: 5-15 heatwave days are forecast for October 2021 in the Guianas, up to around 7 heatwave days in Barbados, St. Croix and in the Windward Islands. Other areas are likely to observe fewer than 5. Prob. no more than 5 heatwave days in Oct. 2021



How many heatwave days from August till October 2021?

USUALLY:

1) In most years, there are 3-7 heatwave days in October in the islands east- and southwards of Puerto Rico, 9-15 heatwave days in the Guianas, but fewer than 3 elsewhere.

FORECAST:

- The number of heatwave days during the last month of the 2021 heat season (October) is expected to be average or fewer.
- Note that areas with more abundant rainfall than usual will see daytime temperatures and the frequency of heatwaves tempered.

IMPLICATIONS:

- In the event of heatwaves, of which up to 3 can occur in October in the Lesser Antilles and up to 5 in the Guianas (especially during dry spells), heat stress in human populations or livestock will sharply increase.
- Beyond October, heat stress should rapidly subside.
