

November 2021 Summary

In the month of November, low to mid-level moisture coupled with low level troughs and favourable mid to upper atmosphere resulted in pockets of heavy to moderate showers and cloudy skies across SVG. In addition, after several days of unsettled weather conditions, the Atlantic High pressure system reestablished itself over our area, which resulted in relatively dry atmosphere and fair conditions. Total rainfall for the month of **November** 2021 at the Argyle International Airport (A.I.A) was **199.7 mm** (**7.86 inches**), with

~9% occurring in the first ten days,~27% in the second ten days and ~64% in the last ten days. There were 21 rainfall days(rainfall greater than 1 mm).Island-wide, the highest monthly rainfall total was 344.8mm (~13.6 inches), which was recorded at the Hermitage station.

The highest maximum temperature 30.4°C was recorded on the 29th, while the lowest minimum temperature value of 21.1°C was recorded on the 12th. Average maximum temperature was 29.6°C and Average minimum temperature was 23.0°C. Average daily mean temperature was 26.3°C.

- **Drought**is not expected to be a concern at this time across SVG.




Fig 4. Regional Precipitation Outlook Dec-Jan-Feb 2021-22

Advisory Statements

Water: The availability of water may be disrupted during the passage of weather systems therefore; residents should store adequate quantities of water for drinking and sanitation purposes.

Agriculture: As SVG transition to the dry season, the possibility of dry spells increases. To ensure food security, farmers are strongly advised to make preparations to employ conservation and irrigation practices.

Health: Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, water availability should be monitored as it is critical for the purpose of sanitization. Conversely, the presence of stagnant water after rainfall may promote the breeding of mosquitoes. Anti-mosquito fogging operation and public awareness campaigns should continue.
