





## Wet day frequency shifts

Forecast for: April to June 2022

USUALLY: Across the region during April-May-June, about 25 to 40 days out of a total of 91 days are wet days (coastal Guianas: 45 to 60 days; ABC Islands: 10 or less).

FORECAST: The total rainfall for AMJ is forecasted to be climatological odds (equal chances for above normal, normal, or below normal) with a similar forecast for wet days compared to the usual across the region.

#### **IMPLICATIONS:**


- Prequency of outdoor activity disruptions due to rainfall should be low, but increasing towards May (Guianas) and June (elsewhere).
- Increasing surface dryness until May will make environmental conditions less conducive to moisture related pests, but engender the peak of the wild fire season.




#### Precipitation outlook











AMJ 2022 frequency of 7-day very wet spells



**USUALLY: 1 to 4 wet spells (ABC Islands up to 2; coastal** Guianas: 3 to 6) occur from April to June, with 1 or 2 of them ending up very wet (ABC Islands: up to 1; coastal Guianas: 1 to 4).

FORECAST: The total rainfall for AMJ is forecasted to be climatological odds (equal chances for above normal, normal, or below normal) with a similar forecast for wet days compared to the usual across the region. An increase in 7-day wet spells is expected east of Saint Martin with a projected increase in very wet spells forecast for the same area in addition to Aruba, Puerto Rico, and The Dominican Republic (low confid.).

#### **IMPLICATIONS:**


- Potentially accelerated recharge of large water reservoirs and soil moisture from May onwards in the Guianas.
- Rising flood potential in May and June, especially in coastal Guianas in view of the increased frequency of very wet spells.

### **Extreme wet spells frequency shifts**

Forecast for: April to June 2022




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**AMJ 2022 frequency of** extreme (top 1%) 3-day wet spells

USUALLY: Up to 1 or 2 extreme wet spells occur between April to June (Guianas: up to 2 or 3).

**FORECAST:** The total rainfall for AMJ is forecasted to be climatological odds (equal chances for above normal, normal, or below normal) with a similar forecast for wet days compared to the usual across the region. An increase in 7-day wet spells is expected east of Saint Martin with a projected increase in very wet spells forecast for the same area in addition to Aruba, Puerto Rico, and The Dominican Republic (low confid.). The frequency of extreme wet spells is forecast to increase in Grand Cayman, and Saint Martin (low to medium confid.).

#### **IMPLICATIONS:**

Flash flood potential throughout the region is a growing concern from May onwards in view of the possible occurrence of extreme wet spells, especially in the Guianas.
