Wet days and Wet spells Outlooks September to November 2022

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
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Wet day frequency shifts Forecast for: September to November 2022

USUALLY: Out of 91 days in Sep-Oct-Nov, there are about 35


to 50 wet days (coastal Guianas: 20-35; ABC Islands: 10-20).

SEASONAL RAINFALL FORECAST:

High probability for at least as wet as usual across most of the region.

SEASONAL WET DAY FORECAST (day when rainfall > 1mm):


An increase in the number of wet days may be expected across most of the region (medium confidence) except for Barbados, Trinidad & Tobago and the Windward islands where fewer wet days than normal may be expected (low to medium confid.).



IMPLICATIONS:

- **Frequent rainfall-related disruptions of outdoor** activities and favourable conditions for moisturerelated pests and diseases in Belize and the islands.
- Less frequent disruptions of outdoor activities and drier conditions in the Guianas up until late November.

Precipitation outlook




Wet days outlook



Wet spells frequency shifts Forecast for: September to November 2022

SON 2022 frequency of 7-day wet spells



USUALLY: Between 3 and 6 wet spells (coastal Guianas: 1-3) occur from September to November, with 1 to 4 of them ending up very wet (coastal Guianas: up to 2).

SEASONAL RAINFALL FORECAST:

• High probability for at least as wet as usual across most of the region.

WET SPELL FORECAST (top 20% of 7-day wet spells):

 More wet spells than usual are forecast across most of the region (*medium confidence*) except for Grenada, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago where slightly fewer are expected (*low confid.*).

VERY WET SPELL FORECAST (top 10% of 7-day wet spells):


• More very wet spells than usual are forecast across most of the region (*medium confid.*) except in the Guyanas, Suriname, and Trinidad (*low confid.*).

IMPLICATIONS:

- Recharge rates of water reservoirs likely faster than usual in view of frequent wet spells.
- The high chance of successive very wet spells translates to a high flood potential in the islands and Belize, but moderate potential in the Guianas.

SON 2022 frequency of *extreme (top 1%)* 3-day wet spells

USUALLY: Up to 2 extreme wet spells occur from September to November, except in the Guianas where it is the dry season.

SEASONAL RAINFALL FORECAST:

 High probability for at least as wet as usual across most of the region.

EXTREME WET SPELL FORECAST (top 1% of 3-day wet spells):

• An increase in the number of 3-day extremely wet spells may be expected across most of the region (*low to medium confidence*) with possibly fewer expected in parts of Guyana and Suriname (*low confid.*).

IMPLICATIONS:

 The very high chance of occurrence of extreme wet spells in the islands and Belize translates to a high to extremely high potential for flash floods and cascading hazards.
