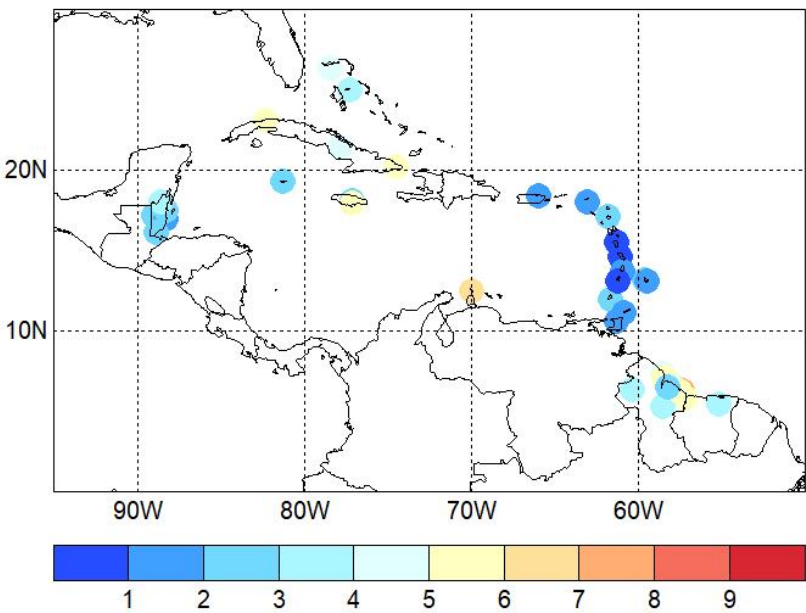

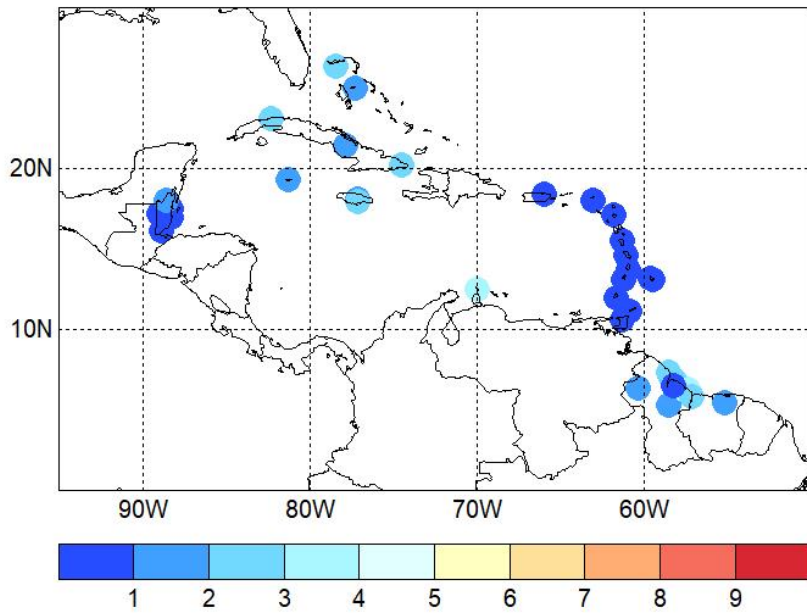


How many 7-day, 10-day or 15-day dry spells do we historically get **on average** from September to November?

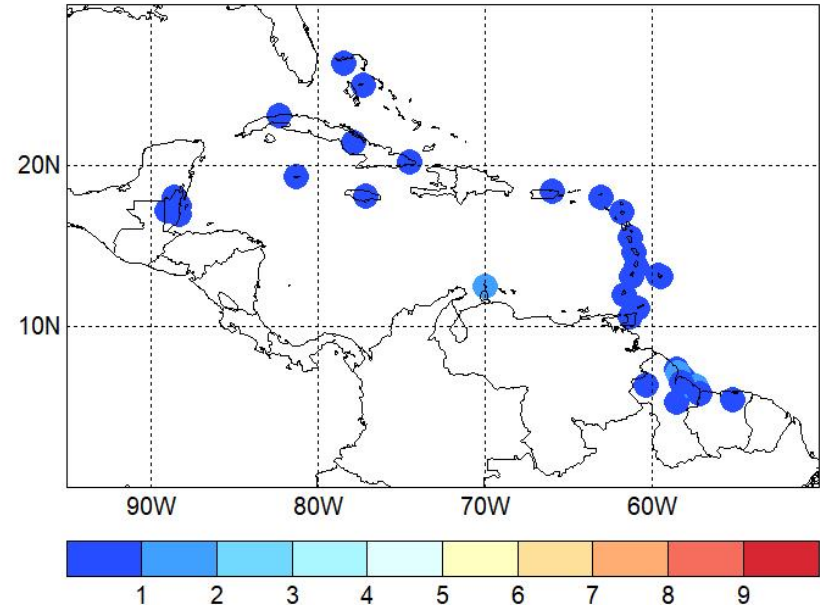
**7-day dry spells**



**10-day dry spells**

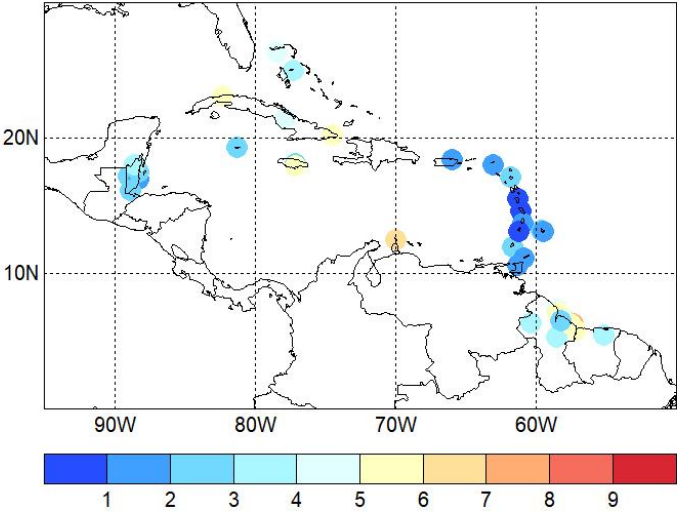

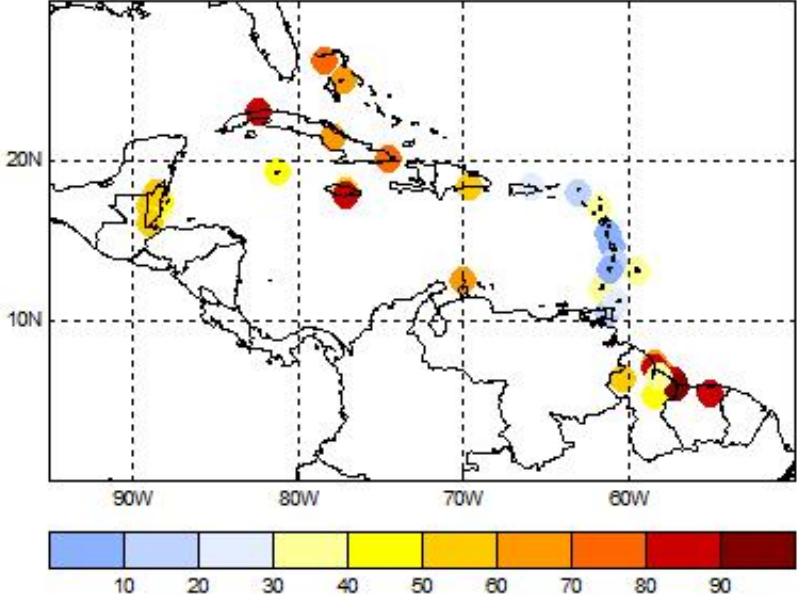
# 7-day dry spells from September to November 2022

Historical avg. number of 7-day dry spells

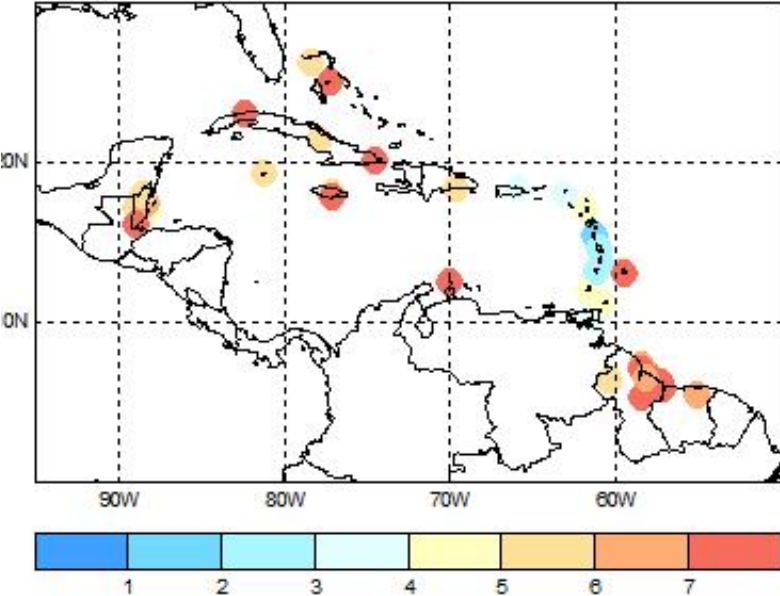


What is the FORECAST for September to November 2022?

Probability of at least THREE 7-day dry spells

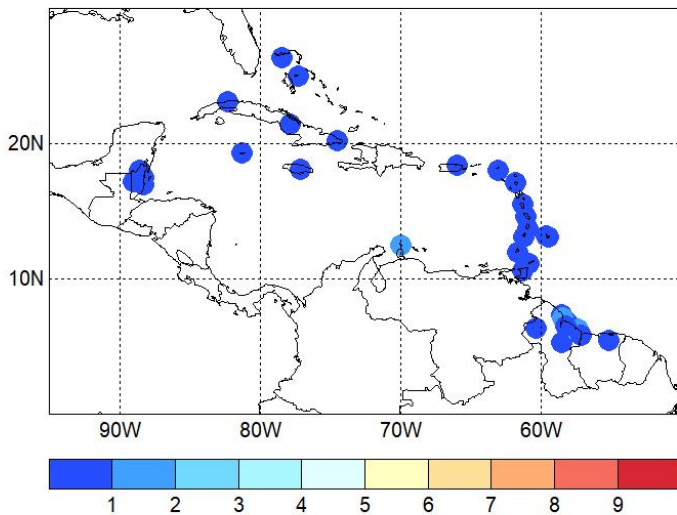


MAX number of 7-day dry spells



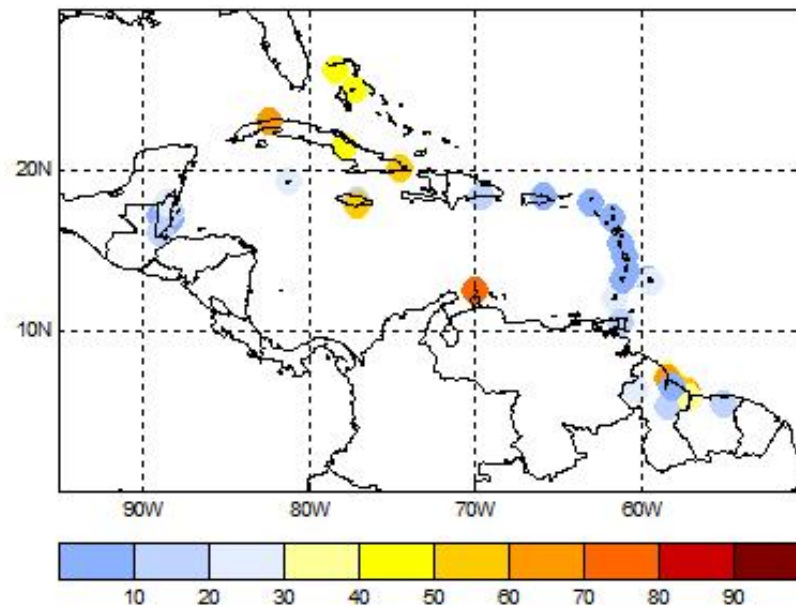
# 15-day dry spells from September to November 2022

Historical avg. number of 15-day dry spells

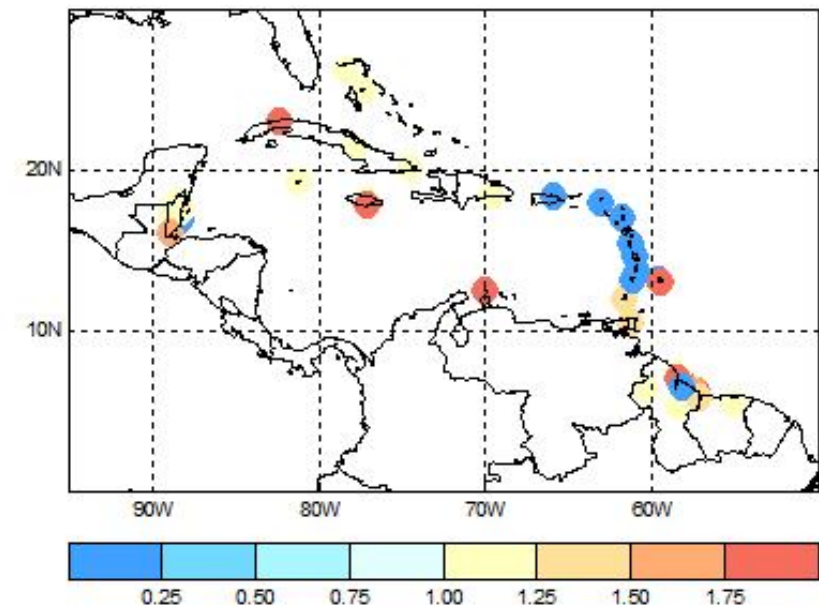


What is the FORECAST for September to November 2022?
