


Figure 1. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing expected mean rainfall totals for districts across Trinidad during the 15-day period (11<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>) September 2022 and percentage probability of occurrence.

#### Eastern, and North-Eastern areas

Moderate chance (65%) of mean daily rainfall up to 6.9 mm.

#### South-Eastern areas

Moderate chance (65%) of mean daily rainfall up to 7.5 mm.

#### Southern areas

Moderate chance (65%) of mean daily rainfall up to 10.9 mm.

#### South-Western areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 11.7 mm.

#### Central, West-Central, and inland areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 10.5 mm.

#### Northern, North-Western areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 9.5 mm.




Figure 2. Rainfall map of Tobago showing expected mean rainfall totals for districts across Tobago during the 15-day period (11-25<sup>th</sup>) September 2022 and percentage probability of occurrence.

## North-Eastern areas

Moderate chance (65%) of mean daily rainfall up to 6.6 mm.

## South-Western areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 6.9 mm.

## Sun and Moon Positions in the Sky September (11<sup>th</sup> –25<sup>th</sup>) 2022.

The sun is presently at 4.0 degrees North latitude and with this position, the day-length or number of sunlight hours in Trinidad and Tobago from September 11<sup>th</sup> will be 12 hours and 13 minutes, decreasing slightly to 12 hours and 05 minutes by 25<sup>th</sup> September 2022. According to the moon's phases, the 25<sup>th</sup> of September (New Moon Phase) is a good day for planting aboveground crops while the 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> are good days for planting belowground crops. However, the 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> (Third Quarter Phase) and 20<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> of September 2022, are poor planting days. These days should be used for removing weeds, clearing land and ploughing fields.

## Highlighted Possible Impacts on Agriculture:

During this second 15-day forecast period of (11<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>) September 2022, expect warm to hot days with moderate to high rainfall at times over western areas of Trinidad and southwestern Tobago. There is a moderate probability (60%) chance for crop irrigation measures to take place owing to warmer and drier conditions over some areas as compared to the last forecast period. Livestock should be provided with fresh cool water during this forecast period to rehydrate particularly during warmer and drier days. On drier days, there is a high probability (80%) chance of heat stress in young livestock, newly germinated and transplanted seedlings onto fields due to infrequent cloud cover and light winds. However, there is a moderate probability (40%) chance for strong wind events that may cause damage to crops and farm <u>Disclaimer</u>

infrastructure. There is also a moderate probability (40%) chance for fungi spread, root and/or fruit rot, insect pests and warm weather diseases to develop in crop beds. River levels will remain at generally low/moderate levels during this forecast period but will become high at times during the 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup> of September. Farmers should be proactive and store seeds, animals and machinery in elevated locations to minimize losses during flooding events.

## Weather Assessment for the period September (1<sup>st</sup> -10<sup>th</sup>) 2022




Figure 1. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during period 1<sup>s t</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> September 2022.




Figure 2. Rainfall map of Tobago showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during period 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

Wet days occurred on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of September over Trinidad and Tobago. The moderate rainfall amounts that occurred across the islands allowed for moderate moisture content in soils, moderate river levels. Crop growth and development rates in general across agricultural lands and vegetation growth in pastures had increased significantly. The rainfall totals maps for the period, 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> of September for Trinidad and Tobago are located below in figure 1 and figure 2.

#### **Temperatures:**

Temperatures were cool to warm during the period 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> September, with the minimum nighttime temperature falling to 21.9 °C and the maximum daytime temperature rising to 33.9 °C, in Trinidad.

Similarly, Tobago temperatures were cool to warm during the period 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> September, with the minimum nighttime temperature falling to 23.2 °C and the maximum daytime temperature rising to 33.3 °C.

## Summary

#### Moderate rainfall amounts are expected on five of the fifteen days.

Five wet days with rainfall amounts ranging between 10.0 mm and 25.0 mm are expected on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>; six relatively wet days with rainfall amounts ranging between 1.0 mm and 9.0 mm are expected on the 11<sup>th</sup>- 13<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> while, four relatively dry days with rainfall less than 1.0 mm are expected on the 16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of September 2022.

#### Trinidad:

Five wet days with rainfall amounts ranging between 10.0 mm and 25.0 mm are expected on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>; six relatively wet days with rainfall amounts ranging between 1.0 mm and 9.0 mm are expected on the 11<sup>th</sup>- 13<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> while, four relatively dry days with rainfall less than 1.0 mm are expected on the 16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of September 2022. The daily rainfall totals are forecast to range between 0.1 mm to 25.0 mm across different farmlands, with fifteenday rainfall totals ranging between 50.0 mm and 125.0 mm. The impactful rainfall events will mostly occur across the western parts of Trinidad. There is a high (90%) probability that flash and riverine flooding will occur during/after heavy <u>Disclaimer</u>

#### rainfall events.

#### Tobago:

Tobago will experience less rainfall than Trinidad. Wet days with rainfall amounts ranging between 10.0 mm and 25.0 mm are expected on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>; six relatively wet days with rainfall amounts ranging between 1.0 mm and 9.0 mm are expected on the 11<sup>th</sup>- 13<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> while, four relatively dry days with rainfall less than 1.0 mm are expected on the 16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of September 2022. The daily rainfall totals are forecast to range between 0.1 mm to 25.0 mm across different farmlands particularly southwestern areas, with fifteen-day rainfall totals ranging between 50.0 mm and 75.0 mm.

#### **Temperatures & Winds:**

The maximum temperatures are expected to remain warm to hot, with temperatures ranging between 32.0°C to 34.5°C throughout the period. However, temperatures are expected to have a real-feel or feels-like between 38.0°C to 48.0°C on most days. The minimum temperatures will range between 24.5°C to 26.0°C during most nights/early mornings, dropping lower in rural areas and valleys.

A mixture of moderate easterly and weak south-easterly winds of average speeds of 10 km/h and 20 km/h are expected, with gusts of 25-50 km/h at times. Moderate to high rainfall totals, mostly low to moderate wind speeds, warm to hot days and warm to hot feels-like temperatures will sustain average evapotranspiration rates in crops ranging between 2.4 to 11.0 millimeters per day.

#### Moisture levels:

Over the fifteen-day period across Trinidad and Tobago, moisture levels are expected to be moderate to high, with average daytime relative humidity values in the lower-50s to lower-80s, in terms of percentage.
