


Figure 1. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing expected mean rainfall totals for districts across Trinidad during the 15-day period (16th-30th) April 2023 and percentage probability of occurrence.




Figure 2. Rainfall map of Tobago showing expected mean rainfall totals for districts across Tobago during the 15-day period (16th-30th) April 2023 and percentage probability of occurrence.

North-Eastern areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 3.0 mm.

South-Western areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 3.0 mm.

Sun and Moon Positions in the Sky April (16th-30th) 2023.

The sun is presently at 9.5 degrees North latitude and with this position, the day-length or number of sunlight hours in Trinidad and Tobago from April 16 th will be 12 hours and 22 minutes, increasing slightly to 12 hours and 30 minutes by 30th April 2023. According to the moon's phases, the 16th, 20th-21st (New Moon Phase), and 24th-26th of April are good days for planting aboveground crops, while 16th of April is a good day for planting below-ground crops. However, the 17th-19th, 22nd-23rd and 27th (First Quarter Phase)-30th of April are poor planting days. These days should be used for removing weeds, clearing land and ploughing fields.

Highlighted Possible Impacts on Agriculture:

During this second 15-day forecast period of (16th-30th) April 2023, expect slightly wetter conditions to occur as compared to the first 15-day forecast period of April. Due to the expected mixed conditions, some drying out of soils will occur across certain parts of both islands. Therefore, frequent irrigation of fields will be necessary at this time to maintain soil moisture. In addition, stronger winds may hamper fertilizer and insecticide spraying routines. Temperatures are already warm, therefore there is a moderate probability (60%) chance of heat stress in young livestock, newly germinated

and transplanted seedlings onto fields. There is also a moderate probability (40%) chance for fungi spread, insect pests and warm weather diseases to develop in crop beds.

Weather Assessment for the period March (1st-10th) 2023.




Figure 1. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during the period 1st to 10th of April 2023.




Figure 2. Rainfall map of Tobago showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during the period 1st to 10th of April 2023.

Very little rainfall occurred during the last ten days resulting in widespread drying over Trinidad. However, Tobago had a wet day (17.7 mm) on 5th of April. The rainfall total maps for the period, 1st to 10th of April for Trinidad and Tobago are located below as figure 1 and figure 2.

Temperatures:

Temperatures were cool to warm during the period 1^{st} to 10^{th} of April, with the minimum nighttime temperature falling to $22.1\,^{\circ}$ C and the maximum daytime temperature rising to $33.0\,^{\circ}$ C, in Trinidad.

Similarly, Tobago temperatures were cool to warm during the period 1^{st} to 10^{th} of April, with the minimum nighttime temperature falling to $22.9\,^{\circ}$ C and the maximum daytime temperature rising to $31.5\,^{\circ}$ C.

Summary

Summary of Expected Weather:

Low to moderate rainfall amounts are expected during the fifteen days.

Relatively wet days with rainfall amounts less than 8.0 mm are expected during the 20^{th} - 27^{th} while relatively dry days with rainfall less than 1.0 mm are expected on the 16^{th} - 19^{th} and 28^{th} - 30^{th} of April 2023.

Trinidad and Tobago:

Relatively wet days with rainfall amounts less than 8.0 mm are expected during the 20^{th} - 27^{th} while relatively dry days with rainfall less than 1.0 mm are expected on the 16^{th} - 19^{th} and 28^{th} - 30^{th} of April 2023. The daily rainfall totals are forecast to range between 0.0 mm to 8.0 mm across different farmlands across the islands, especially along the eastern coastal areas of Trinidad and western areas of Tobago with fifteen-day rainfall totals ranging between 25.0 mm and 50.0 mm in Trinidad and Tobago.

Temperatures & Winds:

The maximum temperatures are expected to remain warm, with daily temperatures ranging between 31.0° C to 33.0° C throughout the period. However, temperatures are expected to have a real-feel or feels-like between 31.0° C to 38.0° C on most days. The minimum temperatures will range between 23.5° C to 26.0° C during most nights/early mornings, dropping lower in rural areas and valleys.

In general, mostly northeasterly and easterly winds of an average speed of 20 km/h are expected, however, gusts can range between 30-50 km/h. Low to moderate rainfall totals, mostly moderate speeds, warmer days, and warmer feels-like temperatures will sustain average evapotranspiration rates in crops ranging between 4.0 to 10.0 mm per day.

Moisture levels:

Over the fifteen-day period across Trinidad and Tobago, moisture levels are expected to be low to moderate, with average daytime relative humidity values in the mid-40s to low-90s, in terms of percentage.
