







How many 7-day, 10-day or 15-day dry spells do we historically get **on average** from September to November?


7-day dry spells



10-day dry spells




15-day dry spells




7-day dry spells from September to November 2023

Historical avg. number of 7-day dry spells




What is the FORECAST for September to November 2023?




15-day dry spells from September to November 2023

Historical avg. number of 15-day dry spells


