


Figure 1. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing expected mean rainfall totals for districts across Trinidad during the 15-day period (1st-15th) November 2023 and percentage probability of occurrence.




Figure 2. Rainfall map of Tobago showing expected mean rainfall totals for districts across Tobago during the 15-day period (1st-15th) November 2023 and percentage probability of occurrence.

North-Eastern areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 10.0 mm.

South-Western areas

Moderate chance (68%) of mean daily rainfall up to 10.0 mm.

Sun and Moon Positions in the Sky November (1st-15th) 2023.

The sun is presently at 13.9 degrees South latitude and with this position, the day-length or number of sunlight hours in Trinidad and Tobago from November 1st will be 11 hours and 45 minutes, decreasing slightly to 11 hours and 38 minutes by the 15th of November 2023. According to the moon's phases, the 9th-10th of November are good days for planting aboveground crops, while the 1st-3rd and 9th-12th of November are good days for planting below ground crops. However, the 4th, 5th (Third Quarter Phase)-8th and 13th (New Moon Phase)-15th of November are poor planting days. These days should be used for removing weeds, clearing land and ploughing fields.

Highlighted Possible Impacts on Agriculture:

During this first 15-day (1st-15th) forecast period of November 2023, expect similarly partly cloudy to cloudy periods with showery episodes as compared to the last 15-day forecast period of October. Mostly light to moderate/heavy showery events will produce some wet days during the forecast period. Therefore, rescheduling of irrigation days on fields to maintain optimal soil moisture would be necessary on days that will have low rainfall. There is a low (45%) chance of heat

stress in young livestock, newly germinated and transplanted seedlings onto fields. There is a moderate (60%) probability for flash and riverine flooding episodes. River levels will be low to moderate at times during the forecast period. There is also a moderate probability (68%) chance for fungi spread, insect pests and warm/moist weather diseases to develop in crop beds.

Weather Assessment for the period October (16th-30th) 2023.




Figure 1. Rainfall map of Trinidad showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during the period 16th to 30th of October 2023.




Figure 2. Rainfall map of Tobago showing measured rainfall totals for varying districts during the period 16 th to 30th of October 2023.

Moderate amounts of rainfall occurred during the 2^{nd} , 21^{st} , 23^{rd} and 27^{th} of October across Trinidad only. The rainfall totals maps for the period, 16^{th} to 30^{th} of October for Trinidad and Tobago are located below as figure 1 and figure 2.

Temperatures:

Temperatures were cool to hot during the period 16^{th} to 30^{th} of October, with the minimum nighttime temperature falling to $23.2\,^{\circ}$ C and the maximum daytime temperature rising to $34.8\,^{\circ}$ C, in Trinidad.

Similarly, Tobago temperatures were cool to very warm during the period 16th to 30th of October, with the minimum nighttime temperature falling to 24.8 °C and the maximum daytime temperature rising to 34.0 °C.

Summary

Summary of Expected Weather:

Low to moderate rainfall amounts are expected during the fifteen days.

Wet days with rainfall amount ranging between 10.0-25.0 mm are expected on the 3^{rd} , 4^{th} and 11^{th} of November while days with 9.0 mm or less of rainfall are expected on all other days.

Trinidad and Tobago:

Wet days with rainfall amount ranging between 10.0-25.0 mm are expected on the 3^{rd} , 4^{th} and 11^{th} of November while days with 9.0 mm or less of rainfall are expected on all other days.

The daily rainfall totals are forecast to range between 1.0 mm to 25.0 mm across different farmlands across the islands, especially along the eastern and western coastal areas of Trinidad, and Tobago. The fifteen-day rainfall totals ranging between 70.0 mm and 100.0 mm in Trinidad, and around 100.0 mm in Tobago.

The maximum temperatures are expected to become warm, with daily temperatures ranging between 29.0° C to 31.0° C throughout the period. However, temperatures are expected to have a real-feel or feels-like between 29.0° C to 38.0° C on most days. The minimum temperatures will range between 24.0° C to 26.5° C during most nights/early mornings, dropping lower in rural areas and valleys.

In general, mostly weak easterly to southeasterly winds with an average speed of 10-20 km/h are expected. Low to moderate rainfall totals, mostly light speeds, warm days, and warm feels-like temperatures will sustain average evapotranspiration rates in crops ranging between 4.0 to 7.0 mm per day.

Moisture levels:

Over the fifteen-day period across Trinidad and Tobago, moisture levels are expected to be low to moderate, with average daytime relative humidity values in the mid-50s to mid-80s, in terms of percentage.
