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



USUALLY: Out of 90 days in Dec-Jan-Feb, there are about 25 to 40 wet days (ABC Islands: 10-35; coastal Guianas: 30 to 50).

FORECAST: DJF may be wetter than usual south of Guadeloupe, but the usual or even drier elsewhere.

• A higher than usual number of wet days is expected in the ABC islands, the coastal Guianas, the Lesser Antilles and Puerto Rico (low to medium confidence).


IMPLICATIONS:


The number of wet days should decease towards
 February and, along with it, outdoor activity
 disruptions and environmental conditions conducive
 to moisture related pests. However, this decrease will
 likely be slower than usual in the ABC Is., the coastal
 Guianas, the Lesser Antilles and Puerto Rico.

Forecast for: December to February 2024-25



USUALLY: Between 1 and 3 wet spells occur from December to February (ABC Islands: 2 to 6; coastal Guianas: 1 to 5), with up to 1 or 2 of them ending up very wet (ABC Islands & coastal Guianas: up to 3).

FORECAST: DJF may be wetter than usual south of Guadeloupe, but the usual or even drier elsewhere.


- An increase in the number of wet spells (low to medium confidence) and very wet spells (medium to strong confidence) is expected in the ABC islands, along the Lesser Antilles, the coastal Guianas and Puerto Rico.
- A slightly lower than usual number of wet and very wet spells is expected in eastern Cuba and Jamaica (low confidence).

IMPLICATIONS:

- Recharge rates of water reservoirs likely even faster than usual in view of frequent wet spells in the coastal Guianas.
- There is a high potential for long term flooding and cascading hazards in the coastal Guianas through early February, and in the Caribbean Islands southwards of Guadeloupe through December, esp. where soils are saturated.



USUALLY: Up to 1 extreme wet spells occur from December to February in Belize and the islands (coastal Guianas: up to 2).

FORECAST: DJF may be wetter than usual south of Guadeloupe, but the usual or even drier elsewhere.

• Little change from the usual number of 3-day wet spells is expected.





IMPLICATIONS:

- The high chance of occurrence of extreme wet spells in the northern Guianas translates to an extremely high potential for flash floods and cascading hazards in those areas.
- This potential decreases from *high* in December to *limited* in February in the Caribbean Islands and Belize.
