




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
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# Flash flood potential associated with excessive rainfall\* from **March to May 2026**

| Flash flood potential | Colour codes  | Probability of excessive rainfall* event |
|-----------------------|---|--|
| <b>EXTREMELY HIGH</b> |    | >80%                                     |
| <b>HIGH</b>           |    | 50-80%                                   |
| <b>MODERATE</b>       |    | 20-50%                                   |
| <b>SLIGHT</b>         |   | 10-20%                                   |
| <b>MARGINAL</b>       |  | 0-10%                                    |

\* excessive rainfall is defined here as at least 30 mm of rainfall within a 24-hour period

**Prob. excessive rainfall event - Mar. to May 2026**





**FORECAST:** *Extremely high* flash flood potential in the Guianas; *high to extremely high* potential in The Bahamas, Belize, the Greater Antilles and mountainous areas of the Lesser Antilles; *moderate to high* potential in most other areas of the Lesser Antilles; *slight to moderate* potential in the ABC Islands, Barbados.

### Hist. # excessive rainfall events - March to May



Historical avg.: Guianas at least 4 excessive rainfall events; southern Belize, mountainous areas in the Greater Antilles 2-4 events; up to 1 or 2 events elsewhere.

**FORECAST:** *No significant change from the usual number of excessive rainfall events (low to medium confidence).*



Historical number of excessive rainfall events\* that could trigger flash floods



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## Historical avg. # excessive rainfall events in March




**Historically in December:** Guianas 1 to 4 excessive rainfall events; up to 1 event in mountainous areas of the Antilles; other locations do not usually observe excessive rainfall in March.
